

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS – SELLAFIELD WARNING AND INFORMING SERVICE APRIL 2016

By registering to receive messages from the Sellafield Warning and Informing service, I understand that:

- In the unlikely event of an incident, I may receive emergency information in the following ways:
  - Voice message to my landline
  - Voice message to my mobile
  - Text message to my mobile
  - Email to my email address
- Sellafield and Alert Cascade Limited (Alert Cascade) cannot be held accountable for any failure in the telephone or cellular networks.
- If I do not receive any of the messages from the Sellafield Warning and Informing service, Sellafield cannot be held accountable or liable.
- Only messages authorised by Sellafield will be sent from the Warning and Informing service.
- The Sellafield Warning and Informing service is a messaging system for emergencies at Sellafield, and if I need to contact the emergency services, I must dial 999 as usual.
- Messages from Sellafield Warning and Informing service may contain emergency instructions and it is important that I listen to the whole message.
- This service is free of charge.
- These terms and conditions may change. If they do change, I will be told about the changes and I can chose to de-register my details at any time.
